## Mandatory ISPS Port Facility Exercise (“MIPE”)

- Provided by:** Falck International Maritime Security (IMS)
- Responsible:** Port Facility Security Officer (PFSO)
- Overall objective:** *“To ensure effective implementation of the provisions of the port facility security plan” (ISPS §18.5 Part B), and “to test communication, coordination, resource availability and response” (ISPS §18.6 part B).*
- Location:** At client’s location (on-scene location).
- Method:** Test of PFSP will be carried out as an exercise, and may include participation of relevant authorities, local emergency units, company or ship security officers, journalists and relatives. The exercise will improve the general understanding of the plan among the port facility personnel and should be carried out at least once a year (ISPS §18.6 Part B)
- Registration:** Will be carried out by the provider according to the PFSP.  
The following will be recorded:
- Name of the exercise
  - Aim of the exercise
  - Method
  - Scope
  - Frequency
- The recorded information should be entered into the facility’s PFSP.
- Objectives of exercise:** Specific objectives of the exercise will be arranged between provider and client.
- Scope:**
- Mobilization capabilities  
*How do we give warning?  
Are there substitutes in case of personnel on holiday?  
Is the speed of mobilization satisfactory?*
  - Control Room  
*Is access control possible?  
Is it possible to communicate with the personnel and to monitor the area?*
  - Communication  
*Reliability and back up.*
  - Information to relatives and the media
  - How to handle relatives or the media on the facility
- Evaluation:** When the exercise is over, a verbal evaluation will be given to the participants. The purpose of the evaluation is to provide an effective tool for adjusting both practical security measures, day-to-day security procedures and if necessary elements of the PFSP.
- Report:** The port/port facility will receive a report based on the results of the exercise. The report should be attached to the PFSP. The PFSO is responsible for the necessary follow-up on the exercise.
